Dear Parent,

Currently we have pupils in school with a severe food allergy to peanuts/nuts. It is important for them that there is strict avoidance of this food in order to prevent a life-threatening allergic reaction. We are asking for your help to provide the children with a safe school environment. Any exposure to peanuts/nuts may cause a life-threatening allergic reaction that requires emergency medical treatment. Young pupils may not be mature enough to be responsible for managing their condition by avoiding allergens, and so by limiting their availability at school, this may reduce the number of allergy related incidents. We are asking that you do not send any peanut or nut containing products to school with your child to reduce the chance of this occurring. If your child has eaten peanuts/nuts before coming to school, please be sure your child's hands and face have been thoroughly washed before entering the school. We understand that prohibiting nuts on site does not guarantee that the school would be a nut free environment, however, we feel it would help minimize the risk. Any nuts brought into school will be sent to the office for safe keeping and should be collected at the end of the day.
