Introduction

When your child first starts Sumdog you may find that the first questions set are below their ability level. After the first 200 questions Sumdog adapts and will increase the level of challenge.

Your child's teacher can also fix the type of question your child answers, so if fractions need reinforcing then you may find these questions are concentrated on for a period of time.

iPad & Android

They'll also let your child use Sumdog's fun features, including Pets and the House, and give you access to Sumdog's progress reports.
