The funding received from Sports Premium has been allocated in the following ways:

- employment of Sports Co-ordinator and Sports Apprentice and additional specialist sports staff to deliver high quality PE and Sports in curriculum time and at lunchtimes, and in After School and Holiday Clubs, and competitions.
- Assist with transport and staffing for competitions
- Affiliation to Telford School Sports Partnership
- Equipment and uniform purchase

Curriculum focus of SP spending September 2016 – August 2017

The school has focused its sports premium on buying in to the Telford & Wrekin School Sports which provides CPD, assistance with Schemes of Work, Lesson Planning, and inter school competitions. Increased level of participation both in school and after school.

Continued development of house competition opportunities for pupils in school, improving their skills and confidence.

Liaison and basic movement delivery with The Learning Tree to aid transition for new Reception pupils.

Measuring the impact of Sports Premium spending September 2016 - August 2017

- 1. Continue to develop simple targets together with methods of assessment from KS1 to KS2.
- 2. Continue to develop and build on the introduction of the HOUSE system by rewarding achievement in sport which can be linked to the assessment process
- 3. Consulting, along with other member schools of the sports partnership, on meaningful competition opportunities, thereby adding extra value to curriculum learning and enhancing achievement and personal development.
- 4. Improved skills in pupils in transition from nursery to Reception classes
